### FINAL PAPER TO BE LODGED WITH THE STATE SECTOR REFORM AND EXPENDITURE CONTROL CABINET COMMITTEE ON THE JOINT BORDER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

#### Purpose

- 1 This report provides you the final draft (attached) of the Joint Border Management System (JBMS) progress report paper for the State Sector Reform and Expenditure Control Committee Cabinet Committee (SEC) meeting on 17 August 2016.

#### Key points

- 2 Customs and the Ministry for Primary Industries (MPI) have prepared the SEC paper in consultation with your offices, Treasury, GCIO, State Services Commission, Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet, and the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (Immigration).
- 3 The paper provides a total overview of the JBMS project, covering:
  - a comprehensive timeline since Cabinet approved the project in November 2009
  - delivery against the business case
  - the budget and commercial situation
  - the next steps to deliver outstanding risk and intelligence tools
  - managing risks associated with the remainder of the project
  - the benefits realised to date
  - what will be, or has been, delivered that was part of the originally envisaged tranche two
  - the paper also seeks a post implementation report back for mid-2017.
