

PRELOAD CONTAINER INSPECTION



A seven-point inspection process is required for all containers:

|----------------------------------|---|
| 1. Front wall | - check for alterations |
| 2. Left side | - check for alterations |
| 3. Right side | - check for alterations |
| 4. Inside/ outside doors | - check for alterations including on the hinges & latches |
| 5. Floor | - check alterations including the container length |
| 6. Ceiling/ roof | - check for alterations |
| 7. Outside/ undercarriage | - check for alterations including with the floor ribs |

Note: Where a container has an external unit attached to it e.g. refrigeration unit, this needs to be visually inspected looking for possible false alterations.

VIEW, VERIFY, TUG AND TWIST (VVTT) SEAL CHECK

- **View and verify** the container and the seal number.
- **Tug and twist** the seal to ensure it is applied correctly
