13 Export Entry information

To establish that a shipment is part of a Customs-approved secure exports scheme, the following information must be recorded in the "Additional Information" section of the export entry. The code SEP is to be entered in the Other Information Code "Type" field and site ID code of the container load site, as listed in Appendix 4 of this Approval, is required in the "Other Information Data" field.

The unique approved seal number must be entered in the Containers section Seal Number field of the entry.
