Under rule 2.5 of the Customs (Arrival Information) Rules 2024 (the **Rules**), I, Christine Stevenson, Comptroller of Customs, make this notice.

Information prescribed under the Rules may be supplied to Customs in the following ways:

- Information specified in Schedule 1 of the Rules may be provided electronically via the New Zealand Traveller Declaration (NZTD) system
- Information specified in Schedule 2 of the Rules may be provided as follows:
 - o by paper form in the NZTD paper declaration (air), for passengers arriving by air
 - o by paper form in the NZTD paper declaration (maritime), for passengers arriving by sea and maritime crew
- Information specified in Schedule 3 of the Rules may be provided in paper format in Form 3A (Customs declared goods)
- Information specified in Schedule 4 of the Rules may be provided as follows:
 - o by paper form in Form 4 (Aircrew Declaration (New Zealand Domiciled Crew)), for air crew domiciled in New Zealand
 - by paper form in Form 5 (Aircrew Declaration (Non-New Zealand Domiciled Crew)), for air crew not domiciled in New Zealand
- Information specified in Schedule 5 of the Rules may be provided as follows:
 - o by paper form in Form 4A (Customs declared goods (New Zealand domiciled crew)), for air crew domiciled in New Zealand
 - o by paper form in Form 5A (Customs declared goods (Non-New Zealand Domiciled Crew)), for air crew not domiciled in New Zealand.
