CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT 1996

CUSTOMS (EXCISABLE GOODS ENTRY) AMENDMENT RULES 2016

PURSUANT to Section 288(1)(f) and 288(12) of the Customs and Excise Act 1996, the chief executive hereby makes the following rules prescribing the form and manner in which goods to which section 70 of the Act applies must be entered, the particulars to be provided in the entries, and the form of application

RULES

1. Title, Commencement, Application and Purpose

- (1) These rules may be cited as the Customs (Excisable Goods Entry) Amendment Rules 2016.
- (2) These rules shall come into force on 1 February 2017.
- (3) In these rules, the Customs (Excisable Goods Entry) Rules 1997 are referred to as the principal rules.
- (4) These rules require approved licensees to include remission in their entry.

2. Interpretation

In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) The term "the Act" means the Customs and Excise Act 1996.
- (b) Any terms used in these rules which are defined in Section 2 of the Act shall have the meanings given to them by that section.
- (c) The term "the Regulations" means the Customs and Excise Regulations 1996.

3. Schedule Amendment

The Schedule is amended by revoking form C6 and substituting the form C6 set out in the schedule of these Rules.

4. Rules applying to Remission

Where the Chief Executive is satisfied that a Licensee has adequate and effective systems for recording and verifying losses under regulations 60 and 63 of the Regulations and claims remission in accordance with regulations 60, 61 and 63 of the Regulations the Licensee must provide in either the C6 form 'Remarks' field or the 'Remarks' field in Schedule 2 the following:

- (a) the total value of the remission(s) for the entry period,
- (b) a description of the remission(s) with reference to regulations 60, 61 and/or 63, and
- (c) the total volume of losses by litre for the entry period.

5. Rules to Continue in Force

Rules to continue in force except to the extent they are amended by these rules.
