NEW ZEALAND CUSTOMS SERVICE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT 1996

CUSTOMS (EXPORT ENTRY) AMENDMENT RULES 2004

Pursuant to section 288(1)(e) and section 288(12) of the Customs and Excise Act 1996 the Chief Executive hereby makes the following amendments to the Customs (Export Entry) Rules 1997.

1 Title

- (a) These rules are the Customs (Export Entry) Amendment Rules 2004.
- (b) In these rules, the Customs (Export Entry) Rules 1997* are called "the principal rules".

2 Commencement

These rules come into force on 1 March 2004.

3 Rule 3 Amended

Rule 3 of the principal rules is amended by deleting the words "in the appropriate form, or by providing the information specified in the Electronic Message Format (E2) as set out in rule 4 of these rules", and substituting the words "in the manner set out in rule 4(a) and 4(ab) of these rules".

4 Rule 4 Amended

- (a) Paragraph (a) of rule 4 of the principal rules is revoked and substituted with the following:
 - (a) Every entry required under section 49(1) of the Act shall be in Format E2 through the use of a Customs computerised entry processing system.
- (b) The following paragraph is inserted into rule 4 of the principal rules between paragraph (a) and paragraph (b):
 - (ab) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this rule, if the Customs computerised entry processing system is not able to accept an entry in Format E2, then a Customs officer engaged in the task of passing export entries may authorise an entry to be made in Form C5 (Export Entry), including any continuation sheet in Form C5CS

(c) Paragraph (b) of rule 4 of the principal rules is amended by replacing the words and figure "paragraph (a)(i) of this rule" where they appear with the words "paragraph (ab) of this rule".

5 Schedule Amended

- (a) The notes on the reverse of Form C5 as provided for in Schedule 1 to the principal rules are hereby deleted.
- (b) The rule numbers set out on Forms C5, C5CS, and Format E2 are deleted

6. Rules to continue in force

Except to the extent amended by these rules the principal rules shall remain in force.

7 Status of Rules

These rules are regulations for the purposes of the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989.
