CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT 1996

CUSTOMS (IMPORT ENTRY) AMENDMENT RULES 2009

Pursuant to section 288(1)(d) and section 288(12) of the Customs and Excise Act 1996 the Chief Executive hereby makes the following amendments to the Customs (Import Entry) Rules 1997.

1 Title

(a) These rules are the Customs (Import Entry) Amendment Rules 2009.

(b) In these rules, the Customs (Import Entry) Rules 1997* are called "the principal rules".

2 Commencement

These rules shall come into force on the 28th day after notification of their making in the *Gazette*.

3. Amended: Substitution of New Form C4D

Form C4D of the principal rules is revoked and substituted with the Form in the Schedule.

4. Rules to continue in force


Except to the extent amended by these rules, the principal rules shall remain in force.

5. Status of rules

These rules are regulations for the purposes of the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989.

2. Imported goods transported from one Customs controlled area to another Customs controlled area, are required to be entered within 20 working days after the date on which the first entry was made in respect of the goods.
3. In all cases a properly completed "Customs Delivery Order" form should accompany the entry at the time of lodgement.
