## **2022 Chief Executive Approval of medium for applications to become a secure exports scheme under the Customs (Applications for Secure Exports Schemes and Scheme Amendments) Rules 2022 (“SES Rules”)**

Pursuant to clauses 1(a) and 6(2)(a) of Schedule 6 of the Customs and Excise Act 2018 (“the Act”) and section 53(2)(c) of the Legislation Act 2019, I, Christine Stevenson, Comptroller of the New Zealand Customs Service (“Customs”), make this approval.

Applications to be approved as a secure exports scheme and applications to amend an approved secure exports scheme must contain all applicable information as prescribed in the SES Rules, together “the prescribed information”.

Applicants must supply the prescribed information through the following approved mediums:

- For those seeking approval as a secure exports scheme, applicants must submit the prescribed information set out in Part A to Schedule 1 of the SES Rules electronically using the Business Connect platform available at [www.businessconnect.govt.nz](http://www.businessconnect.govt.nz).
- For those seeking approval as a secure exports scheme ‘Approved Transport Operator’, applicants must submit the prescribed information set out in Part B to Schedule 1 of the SES Rules to Customs by email at the following address: [SES@customs.govt.nz](mailto:SES@customs.govt.nz).
- For those seeking to amend an existing approved exports scheme, applicants must submit the prescribed information set out in Schedule 2 of the SES Rules to Customs by email at the following address: [SES@customs.govt.nz](mailto:SES@customs.govt.nz).

### **Notes**

Please note that in order to make an entry into Business Connect, an applicant business must first be registered with a RealMe® login. Information on applying for a RealMe login may be found on the [www.realme.govt.nz](http://www.realme.govt.nz) Internet site.

This approval comes into effect on 12 December 2022.
