Request for information under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email to the New Zealand Customs Service (Customs), received on 17 November 2022, in which you requested the following inform tio u e e fici I Information Act 1982 (the Act):

"This Official Information Act request seeks to gauge the extent of Customs' engagement with lobbyists and applies to the following firms:

- Capital Government Relations / Capital GR Ltd
- Thompson Lewis
- Shearson Willis (Sh rson Will's)
- Draper Cormack
- Saunders Unsworth
- Cosgrove & Partners Ltd
- Barton Deakin
- Hawker Britton
- Anacta Consulting

For each of the full calendar years 2020, 2021 and 2022 (until the date of this email) please provide the following information:

- All communications, including emails and correspondence, exchanged with representatives of these lobbying firms
- The amount of money paid to each firm in each year
- The number of meetings, listed by date, between a member of your organisation and any representative of the lobbying firms listed

I also request the following documents that the listed lobbying firms have provided to your organisation for the 2020, 2021 and 2022 years:

 All reports, submissions, talking points, advice, memos, briefings, media training materials, preparation material for select committees, crisis management advice, strategic business advice and analysis, advice on regulatory and legislative decisions and political intelligence including information, biographies and profiles of Ministers, MPs and members of the public service." In response to your request, I can advise that in 2021, Customs engaged Charles Finny of Saunders Unsworth to be the moderator at the Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) Customs Business Dialogue, which was held on 18 June 2021, due to his extensive international experience and expertise in international trade.

Customs has no records of engagement with the eight other firms listed in your request in the period you have specified. As such, this part of your request is refused under section 18(e) of the Act, as the information does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found.

I have set out advice below regarding Customs' engagement with Saunders Unsworth in relation to each of the four points in your request.

All communications, including emails and correspondence, exchanged with representatives of these lobbying firms

In response to this part of the request, please find attached a document titled 'Correspondence between Customs and Saunders Unsworth', which contains eight email communications and one letter between Customs' representatives and representatives of Saunders Unsworth in relation to the engagement of Mr Finny as a moderator of the APEC Customs Business Dialogue.

You will note that Customs is withholding some of the information in the document provided as either it is outside of the scope of the request, or it is withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act, where withholding the information is necessary to protect the privacy of natural persons.

Customs has considered the public interest arguments in favour of making this information available, however, it is considered that these interests do not outweigh the necessity to withhold the information.

The amount of money paid to each firm in each year

In response to this part of the request, I can advise that in 2021 Customs paid Saunders Unsworth a total of NZ\$575.

The number of meetings, listed by date, between a member of your organisation and any representative of the lobbying firms listed

In response to this part of the request, I can advise that in 2021, Customs representatives attended the following two meetings with representatives of Saunders Unsworth:

- APEC Customs Business Dialogue pre-brief on 15 June 2021 at the Majestic Centre in Wellington
- APEC Customs Business Dialogue on 18 June 2021 at the Majestic Centre in Wellington.

All reports, submissions, talking points, advice, memos, briefings, media training materials, preparation material for select committees, crisis management advice, strategic business advice and analysis, advice on regulatory and legislative decisions and political intelligence including information, biographies and profiles of Ministers, MPs and members of the public service that the listed lobbying firms have provided to your organisation for the 2020, 2021 and 2022 years.

In response to this part of the request, I can advise that in the years 2020, 2021 and 2022 (to date), Customs did not receive any of the above documents or information from any of the nine firms listed in the request. This part of your request is therefore refused under section 18(e) of the Act, as the information does not exist or, despite reasonable efforts to locate it, cannot be found.

You have the right, by way of complaint to the Office of the Ombudsman under section 28(3) of the Act, to seek an investigation and review of this response. Information about how to make a complaint is available online at: www.ombudsman.parliament.nz, or you can phone 0800 802 602.
