

Tariff Concession Approvals, Withdrawals and Declines Notice (No.36) 2019

I, Aaron Samuel, Supervising Customs Officer, Revenue and Assurance, New Zealand Customs Service, acting pursuant to section 8 of the Tariff Act 1988 under delegated authority hereby:

- decline to approve in respect of the goods listed in the Fourth Schedule to this notice Tariff concessions for which application was made.
