
Export Lodgement requirements

It is a requirement to report the Secure Exports Scheme (SES) status of a shipment in the export lodgement. This is done by recording the Secure Load Site ID code/s, the SES-approved seal number, and the name of the party affixing the SES-approved seal.

The secure load site(s) ID code is entered in the **Additional Information** field of the Export Entry

- In the Other Information Type field, select code → Secure Export Partnership
- In the <u>Other Information Data</u> field, enter the Secure Load Site ID code of the SESapproved secure load site, as listed in Appendix 1 of your SES Approval Document.

If the container has been loaded at multiple sites, report each Secure Load Site ID code individually.



The SES-approved seal number is entered in the **Containers** section of the Export Lodgement.

- In the <u>Seal Number</u> field, enter the full SES-approved seal number with no spaces.
- In the <u>Sealing Party</u> field, enter the name of the person or company who affixed the SES-approved seal.

Please note this step does not apply to air freight exports.
