

Description of government border-related aviation fees and levies

Agency / Entity	Fee / Levy	Summary
Civil Aviation Authority	Passenger security levy (International)	- Funds aviation security services including screening of passengers and baggage, and other security controls. - Levy collected from airlines on behalf of travellers. - Review cycle: every three years.
	Passenger safety levy (International)	- Supports regulatory oversight and safety assurance of the civil aviation system. - Levy collected from airlines on behalf of travellers. - Review cycle: every three years.
New Zealand Customs Service	Border processing levy (travellers)	- Funds Customs' costs relating to arriving and departing travellers. - Levy collected from airlines on behalf of travellers. - Review cycle: every three years or as determined by the Comptroller.
	Goods management levies (imports, exports)	- Funds Customs' costs relating to imported and exported goods. - Paid by (or on behalf of) importers and exporters. - Review cycle: every three years.
Ministry for Primary Industries	Border processing levy (travellers)	- Funds services to manage the biosecurity risks of travellers arriving in New Zealand. - Levy collected from airlines on behalf of travellers. - Review cycle: every three years or as determined by the Director-General.
	Goods management levies (imports)	- Funds biosecurity costs relating to imported goods. - Paid by (or on behalf of) importers. - Review cycle: every three years.
Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment	International Visitor Conservation and Tourism Levy	- Contributes to the tourism and conservation systems including projects that support sustainable tourism growth and protect the environment. - Paid when applying for a relevant visa or NZeTA. - Review cycle: every five years.

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Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment	Fee for NZeTA request	• Recovers processing costs of New Zealand Electronic Travel Authority requests. • Paid when applying online. • Review cycle: typically, every three years.
	Visitor visa fee and levy	• Fee recovers the cost of processing visa applications. The levy contributes to the wider costs of running and maintaining the immigration system. • Paid when applying for a visa. • Review cycle: typically, every three years. Levy must be reviewed at least every five years.
