Part 1

Rules

Section 1 Title, application, commencement, and interpretation

1.1 Title

These rules are the Customs (Export Entry) Amendment Rules 2019.

1.2 Application of rules

These rules revoke the Customs (Export Entry) Rules 1997 and amend the Customs (Export Entry WCO Message) Rules 2013.

1.3 Commencement

These rules come into force on 1 December 2019.

1.4 Interpretation

1.4(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—

Act means the Customs and Excise Act 2018

Principal Rules means the Customs (Export Entry WCO Message) Rules 2013

1.4(2) Unless the context otherwise requires, a term that is used in these rules and defined in the Act but not defined in these rules has the meaning given in the Act.

Section 2 Rules amended

2.1 Amendment to Principal Rules

2.1(1) The Principal Rules are amended as follows:

- (a) Revoke the heading “*Notes on the Customs (Export Entry) Amendment Rules 2013*” on page 1.
- (b) Revoke Rule 1(d).
- (c) Revoke Rule 1(e).
- (d) Revoke Rule 2(1)(g).

2.1(2) Schedule 1 to the Principal Rules are amended as follows:

- (a) The following is inserted under the headings “Other Information Codes” in Part A:

“Where New Zealand origin is being claimed for preferential tariff rates, to the People’s Republic of China, state the certificate of origin

number in the other information field of the export entry with the code COO.

2.2 Rules to continue in force

The Principal Rules are to continue in force, except to the extent they are amended by these rules.

Section 3 Rules revoked

3.1 The Customs (Export Entry) Rules 1997 are revoked.
