



Tariff (Concessions) Amendment Order 2014

Pursuant to section 9 of the Tariff Act 1988, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following order.

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Order

1 Title

This order is the Tariff (Concessions) Amendment Order 2014.

2 Commencement

- (1) Clauses 3 and 4 of this order come into force on 1 November 2014.
- (2) The rest of this order comes into force on 1 July 2014.

3 Amendment to Concession Reference Number 75

Insert the words, 'except tobacco products', after the word 'gifts' and before the word 'sent' in concession reference number 75, in Part II Concessions of the Tariff.

4 Amendment to Concession Reference Number 82

In concession reference number 82 omit paragraph (a) and replace with the following:

“(a) Either 50 cigarettes, or 50 grams of tobacco or cigars, or a mixture of cigarettes, tobacco or cigars that weighs not more than 50 grams”

5 Concession Reference for Building Materials

Insert after concession reference number 91, in Part II Concessions of the Tariff, the following:

“94 Goods of a kind used in the construction of a residential dwelling as may be approved by the Minister and subject to such conditions as the Minister thinks fit”

6 Rate of Duty

Insert in the column opposite concession reference number 94 (as inserted by clause 5) under the heading Normal Tariff the word “free”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

Clauses 3 and 4 of this order, which come into force on 14 November 2014, remove the gift concession for tobacco products and reduce the incoming travellers' duty-free allowance.

Clauses 5 and 6 of this order, which come into force on 1 July 2014, insert a concession reference relating to goods used in the construction of a residential dwelling into Part II of the Tariff. The effect of the new concession is to remove tariffs on goods used in the construction of a residential dwelling.
