Order

1 Title

This order is the Excise and Excise-equivalent Duties Table (Alcoholic Beverages Indexation) Amendment Order 2026.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 July 2026.

3 Excise and Excise-equivalent Duties Table

This order amends the Excise and Excise-equivalent Duties Table (the **table**) as defined in clause 16 of Schedule 3 of the Customs and Excise Act 2018.

4 Rates of excise duty and excise-equivalent duty on alcoholic beverages amended

- (1) In the table, under headings 99.05, 99.06, 99.10, 99.20, 99.25, 99.30, 99.35, 99.44, 99.45 and 99.50 in Part A and 21.05, 21.06, 22.03, 22.04, 22.05, 22.06, 22.07 and 22.08 in Part B, replace “56.747¢” with “58.492¢”, “\$3.0268” with “\$3.1199”, “\$3.7836” with “\$3.8999”, “\$37.836” with “\$38.999” and “\$68.915” with “\$71.034” in each place.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 July 2026, adjusts the excise and excise-equivalent duties on alcoholic beverages to reflect the movement in the Consumers Price Index (excluding credit services) over the 12-month period ending on 31 March 2026.

This order must be confirmed by an Act before the close of 30 June 2027. If it is not confirmed, it will be revoked on the close of that date. See subpart 3 of Part 5 of the Legislation Act 2019.
