Notes:

- The 29 April 2010 excise rates increases varied so that certain tobacco products, eg, snuff, cigars, cheroots and cigarillos had a smaller across the board increase. This introduced a three-tier structure. Previously there was a two-rate structure.
- The April 2010 legislation also introduced the first of two 10% increases, which occurred on 1 January 2011 and 1 January 2012.
- The 2012 Budget continued the 10% increases with four 10% increases. The first on 1 January 2013 the last on 1 January 2016.
- The 2016 Budget continued the 10% increases with a further four 10% increases. The first on 1 January 2017 the last on 1 January 2020.
